This leaflet will help you as you memorize verses and passages from the Bible, God's Word. As you progress from first grade through sixth grade in our church, you will learn much about God's Word. Each year you will have a different Bible Memory Plan designed just for your grade.

IMPORTANT QUESTIONS

Who will take part? When will we do all these things?

Your Sunday School teachers will encourage you in this program. You will learn some verses on Sunday mornings and you will need to study at home. You should ask Mom or Dad to help you learn – and to learn the verses with you! Your Sunday School teachers will explain more.

How much of this will I need to learn?

We hope you will want to learn all levels of this plan. Pray and ask God what you should do.

And if I do learn it, what then?

At the end of April, we will have a Children's Bible Memory Awards Banquet for each child and their family who completes each level. At that time, each child who has completed the Bronze Medal Level, the Silver Medal Level, and the Gold Medal Level will be awarded the bronze, silver and gold medals respectively.

September 6 **3RD AND 4TH GRADE THEME VERSE**

John 4:35 “I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest.” (NIV)

5TH AND 6TH GRADE THEME VERSE

The purpose of this Bible Memory Plan is to help you develop good Scripture-memory habits. God’s Word will teach you how to know, love, and follow Him. Begin now and you will discover His wonderful plan for your life. Your Sunday School teachers will help and encourage you in this program. They will keep a record of the verses that you have completed. Everyone in your grade will use the same plan. First graders have their own memory plan, second graders a second plan, and so on.

A MESSAGE FOR PARENTS

It is our hope that your child will have your involvement and encouragement in the Bible Memory Plan. Reviewing each day will help your child to memorize and retain these Scriptures for use in daily life. Please help your child by explaining each verse. It will be an inspiration to your child when you learn the verses together.

This program does not replace any of the Sunday School curriculum. There will be some repetition with verses in this plan and verses from the weekly lessons. This serves to reinforce learning and encourage the child when a verse is discovered that has already been memorized. (The New International Version of the Bible is used.) Every child participating in the program will receive an award. Even the child who does not reach the first level will receive a Certificate of Participation. No one will be called on to recite in front of a large group against his or her wishes.

3RD—4TH GRADE BIBLE MEMORY PLAN

REQUIREMENTS

Bronze Medal Requirements: .In this level, you must learn nine verses and 5 key passages.

Silver Medal Requirements: .In this level you must learn eight verses, and the books of the OT in their divisions.

Gold Medal Requirements: In this level, you must learn eight verses, 5 key passages and the books of the NT in their divisions.

Bronze medal requirements must be met before the Silver medal can be achieved. Bronze and Silver medal requirements must be met before the Gold medal can be achieved.

If children miss a Sunday they can make up those verses at any time.
