A BIBLE MEMORY PLAN JUST FOR YOU!

This leaflet will help you as you memorize verses and passages from the Bible, God's Word. As you progress from first grade through sixth grade in our church, you will learn much about God's Word. Each year you will have a different Bible Memory Plan designed just for your grade.

IMPORTANT QUESTIONS

Who will take part? When will we do all these things?

Your Sunday School teachers will encourage you in this program. You will learn some verses on Sunday mornings and you will need to study at home. You should ask Mom or Dad to help you learn - and to learn the verses with you! Your Sunday School teachers will explain more.

How much of this will I need to learn?

We hope you will want to learn all levels of this plan. Pray and ask God what you should do.

And if I do learn it, what then?

At the end of April, we will have a Children's Bible Memory Awards Recognition for each child and their family who completes each level. At that time, each child who has completed the Bronze Medal Level, the Silver Medal Level, and the Gold Medal Level will be awarded the bronze, silver and gold medals respectively.

Bronze Medal Requirements: In this level you must learn 11 verses and tell your teacher the difference between the Old Testament and the New Testament.

Silver Medal Requirements: In this level you must learn another 11 verses and tell your teacher the difference between a book, chapter and verse.

Gold Medal Requirements: In this level you must learn another 3 verses, The Lord's Prayer, and locate in the Bible: Genesis, Psalms, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.

Bronze medal requirements must be met before the Silver medal can be achieved. Bronze and Silver medal requirements must be met before the Gold medal can be achieved.

If children miss a Sunday they can make up those verses at any time.
