## ***Selection and Gift Policy***

All materials selected for the Church Library will be of high quality and beneficial to our members and leaders. Selection/gift guidelines are as follows:

- All materials are subject to approval by the library staff.
- Content should be accurate in facts, scripture interpretation, and doctrine.
- Titles related to religious groups and their beliefs should be constructive in influence, morally sound, and free from racial and religious prejudice, political bias, social injustice, and other evidences of unchristian attitudes and actions.
- Titles should be of high literary and technical quality and reflect sound educational methods.
- Gifts of equipment and furnishings are subject to approval by the library staff with assistance from the church ministerial staff.
- Gifts to the library are encouraged, with money preferred. The Donor, with the library staff, may determine the specifics regarding the choice of the gift. It is preferred that the item be purchased through the library.
- All gifts of pre-owned materials must meet the same standards as purchased items and must be in proper condition. Donations, such as used books and other media, may be added to our collection, disbursed to mission locations or persons needing resources. Unless specified, these donations will not be returned to the donor. No provisional gifts will be accepted.
